



Clairette Ah-Hen - Chief Executive

Clairette Ah-Hen has a wide and in-depth experience in financial reporting and corporate capital structures. Before joining the FSC, she was responsible for monitoring of compliance with financial reporting standards across the Sub-Saharan Africa for a large international accounting firm. She was the first Chief Executive Officer of the Mauritius Financial Reporting Council in 2005, and held the post of Senior Advisor for Corporate Affairs to the Ministry of Economic Development from 2003 to 2004. Prior to 2006, she was an Associate Professor and Dean of the Faculty of Law and Management of the University of Mauritius. Clairette Ah-Hen also chaired several Committees at national level on Accounting and Auditing Standards and worked in collaboration with the World Bank.

She holds an MPhil and a BA (Hons) in Accounting and Finance. She is a fellow member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (ICAEW), and of the Chartered Institute of Management Accountants, UK (CIMA).
