SECURITIES ACT

Rules made by the Financial Services Commission under section 155 of the Securities Act

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Securities (Public Offers) (Amendment No.2) Rules 2021.
- 2. In these Rules –

"Principal Rules" means the Securities (Public Offers) Rules 2007.

- 3. The Principal Rules are amended in rule 3, by inserting the following new paragraph
 - (6) (i) Any public offer of debt securities made under these Rules shall be rated by a credit rating agency licensed by an authority which is identified in Appendix A of the International Organisation of Securities Organisation Multilateral Memorandum of Understanding (IOSCO MMoU) as a signatory to the IOSCO MMoU.
 - (ii) The report of the credit rating on the debt securities must be included in the prospectus being offered to the public.
