## INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to section 6(j) of the Financial Services Act 2007, one of the functions of the Commission is to "collect, compile, publish and disseminate statistics in respect of the financial services and global business sectors"







The **Total Assets** for the financial services sector (*excluding Companies holding a Category 1 Global Business Licence and Insurers*) reached **MUR 58.3 bn in 2021**.

The **Total Income** generated by the entities in 2021 amounted to **MUR 10.3 bn** which represented **an increase of 23%** over the previous year.



The aggregate Profit after Tax for the non-banking financial services sector (excluding Companies holding a Category 1 Global Business Licence) reached MUR 2.1 bn in 2021 compared to MUR 1.2 bn in 2020.

Total Assets for GBCs amounted to USD 717 billion in 2021.

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**Total Assets of Corporate and Trust Service Providers** amounted to USD 366 m in 2021 representing **an increase of 14%** over the previous year.

**Total Income** of **Corporate and Trust Service Providers** witnessed **an increase of 7%**, going up from USD 292 m in 2020 to USD 312 m in 2021.

**Profits** reported by **Corporate and Trust Service Providers**, in 2021 stood at USD 69 m as compared to USD 54 m in 2020 (an increase of 28%).



**Gross Premium** received for **Long-Term Insurance Business** stood at MUR 11.6 bn in 2021 compared to MUR 10.5 bn in 2020 (an increase of 10%).

**Total Assets** of companies in the **Long-Term Insurance** sector stood at MUR 106 bn in 2021 compared to MUR 87.6 bn in 2020 (a growth of 21%).

For **General Insurance Business**, gross premium stood at MUR 11.8 bn in 2021 compared to MUR 11.1 bn in 2020 (an increase of 7%).

For companies in the **General Insurance** sector, **Total Assets** stood at MUR 23.6 bn in 2021 compared to MUR 21.2 bn in 2020 (an increase of 11%).



**Total** (direct) **employment** in the Financial Services sector in 2021 amounts to 9,449


