FSC issues the draft Captive Insurance (Captive Insurance Business) Rules for Public Consultation

In line with its transparent rule-making process, the Financial Services Commission, Mauritius ("FSC") is issuing the <u>Captive Insurance (Captive Insurance Business) Rules</u> (the "draft Rules") for public consultation and is inviting the views and comments of all stakeholders.

For ease of reference and more insight on the draft Rules, the FSC is also sharing the new definitions and descriptions of the <u>categories of captive insurance business</u>. Following issuance, the draft Rules will supersede the current Captive Insurance (Pure Captive Insurance Business) Rules 2016. The draft Rules will therefore cater for the regulatory requirements applicable to all categories of captive insurance business.

It is to be noted that the proposals made or ideas expressed in the draft Rules do not reflect the final stand of the FSC. The draft Rules will be revised in the light of the views and comments received during this consultation exercise.
