NOTICE

of the Enforcement Committee under section 53(2) of the Financial Services Act (FSA)

On 31 December 2014, the Enforcement Committee (EC) of the Financial Services Commission, Mauritius (FSC Mauritius) has, pursuant to section 53(2) of the FSA, issued a notice informing Mr Subudh Caussy of the intention of the EC to disqualify him from holding office or position in a licensee of the FSC Mauritius for a period not exceeding five (5) years and inviting written representations in this respect.

Service of the notice has been effected at the residential address of Mr Subudh Caussy at Route Royale, Plaines des Papayes by Registered Post with Delivery Advice.

The notice has not been delivered since Mr Subudh Caussy has gone away.

Notice is hereby given to Mr Subudh Caussy that he is required, within a period of 15 days from the date of first publication of this Notice on 14 January 2015, to submit written representations to the EC as to why he should not be disqualified from holding office or position in a licensee of the FSC for a period not exceeding five (5) years under section 7(1) (c) (iv) of the FSA.
