

INVESTOR ALERT: Mornefundvex.com

It has come to the attention of the Financial Services Commission, Mauritius (FSC) that **Mornefundvex.com/Morne Fundvex** is advertising its platform as the preferred choice for crypto traders in Mauritius to buy, sell and manage cryptocurrency as it uses artificial intelligence and advanced algorithms for trading purposes.

The FSC has also become aware that **Mornefundvex.com/Morne Fundvex** is promoting its platform using potentially fake testimonials, presumably from Mauritians, on its website (<https://morne-fundvex.com/>) in order to promote its services.

The FSC hereby informs the public that **Mornefundvex.com/Morne Fundvex** and/or any other individuals or representatives or promoter groups operating under this name **are not and have not, at any point in time, been licensed and/or regulated by the FSC.**

The public is therefore urged to exercise caution in dealing with **Mornefundvex.com/Morne Fundvex** and any other individuals and/or entities allegedly claiming to be registered /authorised/ licensed by the FSC.
