He has given evidence to the UK All-Party Parliamentary Group on Blockchain and Cryptoassets, and is a named contributor to the UKJT legal statement on cryptoassets and smart contracts. His work is award winning including being a finalist at the Crypto A.M. Awards 2021. He has been awarded a Fellowship of FRSA as a result of his work in blockchain and cryptoassets.
