The Financial Services Commission, Mauritius (“FSC”) wishes to inform members of the public that it has come to its attention that an entity operating under the name **DistributeX** is claiming on its website (<https://dx9001.com/#/register?code=8YYF95Q>) to provide comprehensive marketing support for the implementation of global cryptocurrency market brand positioning, and presumably to have deep understanding of the cryptocurrency market's project ecosystem and cutting-edge marketing concepts.

It has further been observed that **DistributeX** is inviting members of the public to attend a gathering described by the entity as “an official employee meeting”.

The FSC hereby informs the public that **DistributeX** and/or any other individuals or representatives or promoter groups operating under this name **are not and have not, at any point in time, been licensed and/or regulated by the FSC.**

The public is therefore urged to exercise caution in their dealings with **DistributeX** and with any other individuals and/or entities allegedly claiming to be registered /authorised/ licensed by the FSC.
